Free Meals Program Release

Norwayne Local Schools will begin offering Free Breakfast and Lunches to all children (18 and under) in the Norwayne School District from September 21 thru December 18, pending U.S.D.A. funding. This program was released by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and will continue as funds allow through the end of the calendar year. This program is available for all students in the district regardless of status for free or reduced lunches.

All Students attending Norwayne Schools in person will have Free Breakfast and Lunch available each day school is in session. Only Type A Lunches will be served free of charge. Students should sign up for meals as directed within their respective buildings. Students who have paid for Breakfasts or Type A Lunches during the month of September will have those amounts refunded to their student lunch accounts.

Meals will be available for pick-up by families of students choosing the remote learning option, or families of preschoolers who live within the district. Families choosing to pick up meals must notify the office of the building they would normally attend. Families with students in multiple buildings will be assigned a pick up point for all family members.

Meal Distribution for Remote learners and preschoolers will take place at the rear door of the Elementary cafeteria on Thursdays from 2:00 – 3:00 PM, and in the parking lot at the rear of the High School on Thursdays from 2:00 – 3:00 PM. Each Child will receive Breakfast and Lunch Items for five days each week. Families must call the school building by 3:00 PM on Monday to reserve meals to pick up on Thursday.
