Please read this letter carefully. The Norwayne High School yearbook staff is already in the process of creating the yearbook. We're sure you realize the memories this book will hold for years to come, and we would appreciate your assistance.

Senior Pictures: If your son/daughter has not had their senior picture taken yet, please make an appointment as soon as possible because senior portraits are due in January. Submissions do not have to be professional photos; Any high quality, appropriate portrait can be used. We appreciate these early submissions so we can begin working on these pages, as they take a lot of time to format. We will not accept ANY pictures after January. Digital copies look better in the yearbook because they are higher quality than a scanned photo.

Toddler Pictures: As this is your son/daughter's last year, we would like to make this yearbook special for him/her. We have a long-standing tradition for seniors; we like to include a baby picture for every Norwayne senior, but to continue this we need your help. Toddler pictures for the yearbook should be submitted as soon as possible.

Through the Years: Through the years, pictures from school events will also be accepted with the same guidelines as above. They will be included in the yearbook ONLY if there is enough room and at the discretion of the editors. Only submit pictures of students. We will not use pictures with parents/siblings/friends that are not Norwayne seniors. Please send in pictures with multiple students. If you would like to include more pictures of your own child over the years, please read about grad ads in the next section. Please identify the children in these pictures.

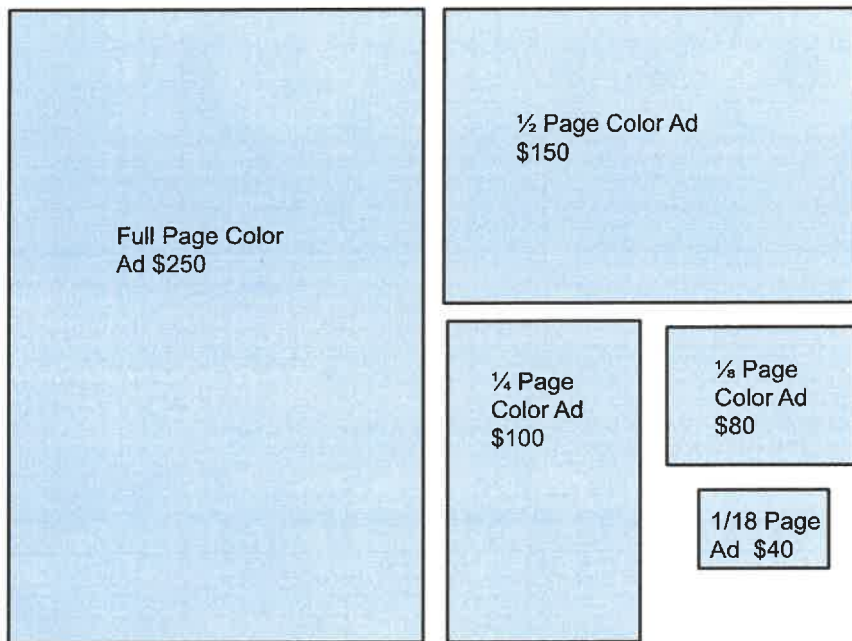

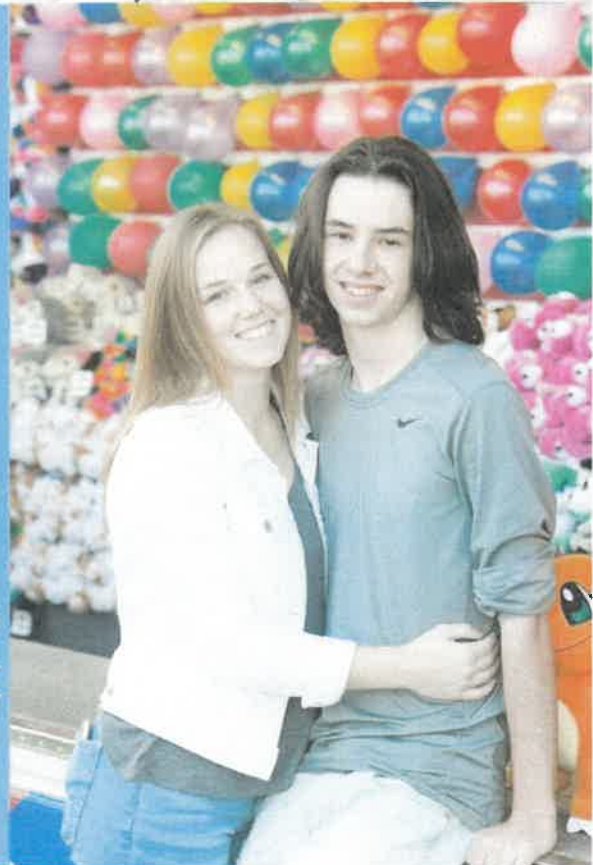
