Dottie Curie was a 1972 graduate of Norwayne High School and spent her entire life in Wayne County, Ohio. Despite not having opportunities for post-secondary education and fulfilling her life-long dream of becoming a nurse, she demonstrated her care and compassion in many other ways through her friends, family and community. She was known for rooting for the underdog, helping others less fortunate, challenging injustice and offering support to marginalized populations. She thoroughly enjoyed attending Norwayne sporting events, especially track and cross country, and her cheers could be heard from anywhere on the track. She is survived by her son Josh Curie, Norwayne class of 2004 and Andrea Curie (Knowlton), Smithville class of 1998, who will be selecting and awarding the scholarship recipient.

This scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 is to be awarded annually to one outstanding senior who best meets most, if not all, of the following criteria:

- 1) Acceptance and enrollment into a 2 year or 4 year college program or a trades program.
- 2) Maintains a Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- 3) History of public service, social justice, volunteerism, or community engagement
- 4) Complete an essay between 500 and 1,000 words that addresses the prompt: "How will I be the change I wish to see in the world?"
