RULES AND REGULATIONS:

To be eligible for the Holmes-Wayne Electric Scholarship Awards, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applications:

- 1. Applicants must be sons, daughters, or legal wards of Holmes-Wayne Electric Cooperative, Inc. residential members, living on the lines and receiving service at the time of competition.
- 2. Applicants cannot be immediate family members of or reside with individual employed by HWEC.
- **3.** Applicants must be a graduating high school seniors with all basic credits for college, or proper vocational, or technical school entrance. (*Proper vocational or technical schools* is defined as post-secondary institutions where credits can be transferred to state-accredited four-year colleges.)
- 4. Applicants must have a current career average of 3.6 or above on a 4.0 scale, or equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.
- 5. Applications for the local Holmes-Wayne Electric Cooperative, Inc. competition must be submitted (typed) on the forms provided by HWEC. Application forms must be returned to the co-op office by Friday, January 24, 2025. Application information must be confined to the official form. The only attachments permitted are: transcript, teacher recommendations, and one photo of the applicant. (Teacher recommendations shall not exceed 500-words.)
- 6. Applicants who have received "full ride" scholarships (tuition, room, board, and books) to the schools of their choice are not eligible.
- 7. Qualified applicants will be contacted for an interview in late February.
